

To start learning at Khan Academy, sign in with your Facebook or Gmail login, or other email address. Once you are signed in, set up your profile if you like.

You can select a topic by subject or run a search. Let's use the search box first. (renaissance art)

Your search may contain several different types of results such as articles, exercises - like a quiz, any related computer program tutorials, specific topics or videos.

And here's a helpful tip. If you have trouble finding what you want, use the Google-powered site search. This will give you a different set and order of results which may help you find what you are looking for.

Now let's choose something from the subjects menu. Broad subject areas include math, science, including health and medicine, economics and finance including entrepreneurship and capital markets, arts and humanities, and computing. The partner content includes things like tours and behind the scenes information from some of the most famous museums in the world and other specialty content offered by organizations, think tanks, government programs, and institutions of higher learning.

Make your selection (health and medicine) and start exploring the things that you can learn. When you find something of interest, start learning at your own pace.
