## Video Transcript for *Startpage: Private Browsing and More*

This is Startpage. It's a search engine like Google except it doesn't track or store your information. Type your search words into the box and click the Go button. Let's look at a few of the features. On the left, you can change the date range of your search. Search for images or videos by simply clicking on those links at the top. Click the triple bar symbol to access and adjust your personalized settings. Click on Advanced for more web search controls. Here you can do things like specify that your search contain an exact phrase or that a certain word be omitted from any of the search results. You can also limit your search to a particular web address or domain type such as .edu. There are parameters that you can set for language, file type, date, and country. You might want to explore these in more detail on your own. Click on the Tips link for more information. I'll go back to my search by clicking on Web. To browse your search results you can either click the main link to the web page or you can click the Proxy link. When you use the proxy link, StartPage removes the javascript from the web page and you remain anonymous. This may cause the page to load slower and it may not view normally either, as in this example, where you can see the template's formatting just doesn't look quite right. In the upper right corner, there are links for going back to your search results or to view the unproxied version of the page. If you do go to the site without using the proxy service then just remember that you're no longer browsing anonymously. Thanks for watching!
