3 iPad Multitasking Features

The first multitasking feature I'll cover is the Slide Over. This feature allows you to slide an overlay of a secondary app on the right-side of the screen to view and use. Swipe left from the middle right of the screen for the overlay to appear.

To choose another app to view in the Slide Over area swipe down on the top bar and select the app you want. If the app isn't showing here, go and open it and then come back and it should be available.

To use two apps side-by-side move the Slide Over control bar to the left.

You can still switch apps on the right-side using the bar at the top but now you can also switch apps on the left-side too. Simply double-click the home button to select an app that's already open or single-click the home button to select any app.

This last multitasking feature lets you continue to watch a video while doing something else on your iPad. To use it, tap the Picture-in-Picture icon - it typically looks like this. You can drag the video to another place on the screen with one finger and even resize it a bit by pinching or spreading with two fingers.

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
